

Intelligence and Investigations Advisory Group Meeting
Meeting Statement
16 May 2019

The first meeting of the Intelligence and Investigations (IAI) Advisory Group was held via teleconference on 16 May 2019. The primary purpose of this meeting was to facilitate introductions, provide an overview of the Sport Integrity Taskforce's proposed approach to the development of intelligence and investigations functions of Sport Integrity Australia, and open the floor to general discussion.

Members were provided with background information that will assist them in their role of providing strategic advice and guidance to the Sports Integrity Taskforce on the development of intelligence and investigations capabilities of Sport Integrity Australia.

Members discussed and noted an early adaptation of a law enforcement taskforce model devised by the Sports Integrity Taskforce during the early development of the Government Response to the Wood Review. Members discussed and noted that formal development of the model (or similar) will be workshopped at the upcoming IAI Advisory Group meeting.

The Taskforce opened a discussion regarding the importance of ensuring that the intelligence and investigations model implemented by Sport Integrity Australia had a strong focus on two-way communication, with sport, betting, and other stakeholders receiving, as well as providing information from Sport Integrity Australia.

Next Meeting/Next Steps

The Taskforce and Chair led a discussion regarding process and next steps, including links with other Advisory Groups and Working Groups established by the Sport Integrity Taskforce as matters develop.

Members noted that the broader stakeholder cohort will continue to be consulted regarding the development of intelligence and investigations function of Sport Integrity Australia, and this will occur through face to face meetings, and via Citizen Space (online consultation portal).

Members noted that the Taskforce is developing a long-term program of meetings across all Advisory and Working Groups.

The next meeting of the Group will be scheduled for early September 2019.
